Conditions for all Scholarships:

1. **Must be a Seton Hall undergraduate student majoring in Elementary Education, Special Education or Secondary Education;**
2. **Must be enrolled full time and have at least one more year of studies to complete;**
3. **Must be a student in good standing;**
4. **Criteria will be based on references, career goals, philosophy of education, reasons for applying, need, academic record, work samples, service activities and performance in the field, if available;**
5. **The award is for one year and the amount is dependent on available funding.**

Additional Conditions:

1. **For the Jerome D. Greco scholarship, preference will be given to students who demonstrate a commitment to service activities;**
2. **For the Elizabeth Giuliano Magnes scholarship, the applicant must be a junior with a minimum grade point average of 3.5;**
3. **For the Ruth Foley scholarship, the applicant must be female.**

Procedure:

Fill out a Financial Aid Form (available in Enrollment Services, Bayley Hall, main floor) as soon as possible; no application will be considered without it.

Prepare a folio to support your application. Your folio should include sections for each of the following areas: the application form; a personal biography; resume; your reasons for applying; a statement of need; your educational/career goals; your philosophy of education; reference letters; field experience evaluations (not required of freshmen); samples of exemplary work (term papers, lesson plans, exams, etc.); a description of service or volunteer activities; and transcripts.
